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F1 Service—Retrofits—Rebuilds

FilterONE USA specializes in the manufacturing, installation, maintenance, turnkey refurbishments and service contracts, for municipal and industrial wastewater treatment equipment. Our team has over sixty-five (65) combined years of experience in the water and wastewater Industry. The principals of FilterONE were previously employed by a major equipment manufacturer prior to starting this company.

FilterONE is staffed by service engineers who have been servicing and rebuilding all types of equipment for over twenty-five (25) years. FilterONE does not use personnel from labor pools or temporary labor. It is our philosophy that specialized work must be completed by experienced professionals who can complete a complex mechanical task with the least amount of supervision.

FilterONE's service technicians have completed hundreds of on-site equipment refurbishments since the Company was started in 2003. We have traveled as far west as California and Washington State, and as far north as Maine. Completing rebuilds on-site, instead of shipping the equipment back to the factory, greatly reduces equipment downtime, and minimizes labor needed by plant people while equipment is out of service.

Sometimes for more extensive refurbishments, for example when the equipment requires stripping to the frame, and completely rebuilding with all new components, the equipment needs to be shipped back to our shop. The above photos show the “before” and “after” conditions of a bar screen that was totally refurbished at our facility in Deerfield Beach FL. Having the capabilities to complete total refurbishments under controlled conditions provides the customer with a like-new machine at a fraction of the cost of a replacement.

One example of an on-site refurbishment is when we are able to visit the plant, and complete an in-depth inspection. From the inspection, we compile a complete list of the needed parts. Once we have an order to proceed, we can then mobilize to the site and complete the refurbishment in as short a period of time as possible. This of course depends upon equipment size and scope of supply. With this type of refurbishment we have the capability of providing the customer with minimal down-time (which means less raking) and completing the work in an approximately a four to five (4-5) day period.

The photo's below show a project that was completed during the winter at a facility in the mid-west. On this project, the screening belt was refurbished on site, while the screen frame was taken to our facility where it was completely abrasion blasted and painted. The frame was then returned to the facility where the belt and other components were reassembled, completing the refurbishment. This screen was totally refurbished within a two (2) week period.
